These are policies that not only influence the quality of life of individuals but also define and redefine the broad contours of social life. The policies covering pollution control and environment preservation, women education and empowerment are a few notable instances of such initiatives.

Governance is about the action or the manner in which the systems and processes are implemented by any agency- the government, the market or any other network. Good Governance is about accountability, transparency and equity. It is also about being inclusive and participatory in nature. It is not about making the right decision, rather choosing the right path towards that decision. Advocacy encompasses a wide range of activities that aim at influencing the decision making in public life.
