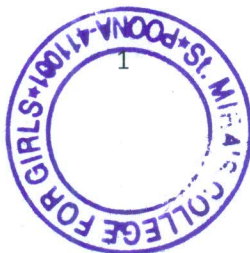

**Resolution:** The Minutes of the previous Academic Council Meeting held on 08-04-2022 were read and confirmed.

**Agenda 2:** To present the curriculum of the TYBA Generic Electives Course (of 4 credits to be spread over Semesters V & VI), as prescribed by the Savitribai Phule Pune University for approval by Academic Council and implementation thereof w.e.f. 2022-23.

**Resolution:** The curriculum of the TYBA Generic Electives Course [Semester V & VI] of 4 credits, as prescribed by the Savitribai Phule Pune University was unanimously approved by Academic Council for implementation w.e.f. 2022-23.

**Agenda 3:** To propose the conduct of the SPPU prescribed Generic Elective (GE) credit course for T.Y.B.A. as a self-paced online credit course.





**Resolution:** The Academic Council members appreciated and approved the conduct of the SPPU prescribed TYBA Generic Elective (GE) credit course as a self-paced online credit course.

Professor (Dr) Rajeshwari Deshpande, while appreciating the conduct of the same as a self-paced online course; requested all to take a call on mandatory courses in the context of the New Education Policy, due for implementation soon, wherein students will have the discretion to exercise choice in selection of academic courses- an aspect which could be conveyed to the University authorities. This fact was endorsed by the Principal In-Charge.

**Agenda 4:** To present before the Academic Council the Course Work for the PhD Programme in Women Studies at St. Mira's College.

**Resolution:** The Course Work for the PhD Programme in Women Studies at St. Mira's College. was presented before the Academic Council, as a course to be conducted in hybrid mode- online as well as offline.

Dr. Meena Chandawarkar appreciated the fact that the hybrid mode offered convenience and flexibility to student; but also stressed that due to its mandatory nature; personal involvement was also very important in order to make it effective. Dr. Damayanti Gharpure suggested incorporation of an introduction to Tools for Data Analysis as a part of the Course Work, which has already been done.

She reassured the Academic Council that the number of MILE courses conducted in 2022-23 could be in the range of 2-8 courses.

Dr. Meena Chandawarkar expressed appreciation and stated the uniqueness of the courses, keeping in mind, the New Education Policy.

Dr.Manju Nichani enquired about the minimum number of students required for conduct of the said Value Added and other Courses. Dr Shalini Iyer, Vice Principal endorsed that the conduct of the said courses was viable only when the course could attain break-even level.

**Agenda 6:** To discuss any other matter with the permission of the Chair.

It was proposed that NCC could be considered for award of twonon-CGPA credits, if a student secures a certificate for NCC from a neighbouring college.



**Resolution 6:** The proposal of considering NCC as an option for award of 2 non-CGPA credits was accepted and approved since Dr. Manju Nichani and Dr. Meena Chandawarkar opined that the proposal fit into the UGC criteria of permitting transaction of 20% of syllabus from another institution.

Just like the other options for non-CGPA credits, approved in the previous Academic Council meeting of 08-04-2022, the option of NCC for award of 2 non-CGPA credits, was to be completed at the Second year or Third year level of the Degree Programme (all streams) in Semester III, IV or V.

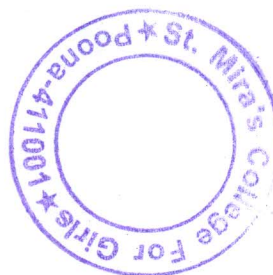

**Agenda 4:** To present for approval to the esteemed Academic Council, the revised Third Year Syllabi of the B.A. (MBAR01/Sociology, MBAR01/Economics, MBAR01/English, MBAR01/Psychology) and B.Com.(MBCO02) Programs to be conducted at our College for transaction w.e.f. June 2022-2023.

**Resolution:**

- 2) All the T.Y.B.A. courses were appreciated and approved by the members. (Please refer to Annexure 2 for List of Courses)
  - a) Dr. Gulshan Gidwani – appreciated all the course syllabi that was being introduced. She also suggested sharing of resources wherever possible.
  - b) Dr. Rajeshwari Deshpande – suggested the Dept of Sociology and Psychology to teach the students an open software like 'R' instead of SPSS since it is expensive and not easily available.
  - c) Dr. Manju Nichani– too appreciated all the course syllabi that was being introduced. She also pointed out that sharing resources may not be possible always as the methodology and approach of subjects varies.

#### **Recommendations by Dr. Gulshan Gidwani**

1: Orientation of students of SYBCOM for preparation of Cost Sheets.

It was suggested that the faculty of Cost and Works Accountancy subject should orient the students specializing in this subject to prepare Cost Sheets so as to enable them to understand the procedure of correlating the various overheads with respect to an academic institution.

2: Conducting a Faculty Development Programme on E-filing.

It was suggested that a Faculty Development Programme should be conducted to orient them to understand the procedure of E-filing and the various nuances of tax implications of each individual assessee. This suggestion was noted by the Department of Accountancy and will be implemented shortly.

3: Alignment of content of syllabus with Entrepreneurship Development Cell (EDC)

Dr. Gidwani appreciated the contents of the syllabus as it is in line with the objectives of the Entrepreneurship Development Cell (EDC) of the College. Further she recommended that

Dr. Gidwani suggested the introduction of the different types of banks in the Banking and Finance syllabus. The members of the Department of Business Economics and Banking informed Dr Gidwani that this part is covered in FYBCOM syllabus of Banking and Finance.

**Agenda 1:** To present for approval to the esteemed Academic Council, the revised Third Year Syllabi of the BBA-(MBBA04), BBA(CA)- (MBCA05) and B.Sc.(Computer Science)-(MBCS03) Programs to be conducted at our College for transaction w.e.f. academic year June 2022-2023.

**Resolution 1 for T.Y.BBA:** All the T.Y.B.B.A. courses were appreciated and approved by the members. (Please refer to Annexure 3 for List of Courses)

**Recommendations:**

- 1) Dr. Gulshan Gidwani suggested to evaluate the Internships as a flexi test-based internship, wherein the students can write a mini-document and present the same as a project work.
- 2) Dr. Gulshan Gidwani also suggested not to give exemption for Semester 6 internal assessment to those doing internships, as it will not be a level playing field for the students.
- 3) Dr. Manju Nichani appreciated the concept of Internships and commented that the documentation in autonomous colleges is good and helps to maintain records.
- 4) Dr. Arwah Madan put forth the concept of white-listing wherein students can approach the companies for internships, through an agency, and a list of companies will be created which will be maintained and added over the years.
- 5) Dr. Gulshan Gidwani suggested that a forum can be created from the college inviting people to be part of the same and a mini brochure can be created. The mini brochure could highlight the core competencies of the students, the nature of work that can be handled by them and the expected learning outcomes. This will help the internship provider to offer the right kind of internship to the students. Dr. Manju Nichani shared this view point.
- 6) Dr. Manju Nichani appreciated the idea of having a Viva for the students undergoing internships, involving an external examiner, which would help to maintain objectivity.

**Resolution 1 for T.Y. BBA(CA):** All the T.Y.B.B.A.(CA) courses were appreciated and approved by the members. (Please refer to Annexure 4 for List of Courses)

**Recommendations:**

- 1) Dr. Gulshan Gidwani suggested to involve students to analyze what kind of net-working can be done for better internet connectivity in the college. This can be a very good internal resource for the College.
- 2) Dr. Gulshan Gidwani pointed out and enquired that as we are going to provide the internet access with boosters in the college to the students, is there any way where the

faculty could provide expertise on how to use jammers or firewalls in the college, to block certain sites and make them inaccessible. Mrs. Swati Pulate, suggested that there is a possibility to use firewalls. Dr. Gidwani advised the department to suggest cost and outcome efficient solutions to the college for the same.

**Resolution 1 for T.Y.B.Sc(CS):** All the T.Y.B.Sc. (Computer Science) courses were appreciated and approved by the members. (Please refer to Annexure 5 for List of Courses)

**Recommendations:**

- 1) Dr. Manju Nichani appreciated the introduction of many new subjects in the TYB.Sc Computer Science Syllabi.
- 2) Dr. Damayanti Gharpure also appreciated the introduction of Python Programming in the syllabi.

Dr. Gulshan Gidwani made an observation about all the Curriculum Highlights presented and suggested that the Topics of the curriculum should be highlighted rather than the learning outcomes. Dr Gidwani was reassured that the same would be adopted and implemented in the successive Academic Council Meetings.

Dr. Gulshan Gidwani also reinforced and enquired whether the syllabus has a minimum 25% change as compared to the SPPU. Dr Gidwani was re-assured that the minimum 25% change in syllabi had been adhered to.

**Agenda 2:**

(i) To present for approval to the esteemed Academic Council, the Certificate Course on Stock Market and Investment of 100 hours [30 teaching hours, 20 practical hours, 50 hours of self-learning (inputs provided)] to be offered by the Department of Business Economics & Banking. Training on various apps for the same course will be provided. This course is to be started from October 2021, for in house students as well as outsiders.

(ii) To present for approval to the esteemed Academic Council, Certificate course on Quantitative Economics which comprises of 60 Hrs. The course focuses on Mathematical and Statistical approach to Economics. The faculty for this course is Prof. Sujata from S.K. Somayya College, Mumbai who has an experience of 20 Yrs. in the field of Economics.

(iii) To seek approval of the esteemed Academic Council members for the following courses run by the Dept of Psychology:



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- a. The Post Graduate Diploma in Dance Movement Therapy (2020-2021) has seen an extension in the practical hours input for syllabi transaction from 650 hours (2020-21) to 800 hours (2021-22).
- b. The Certificate Course in Mindfulness Based Counselling -Listening with embodied presence (2018-2019, 2019-2020) which was of 420 hours duration has been converted to a Post graduate Diploma Course in Mindfulness Based Counselling -Listening with embodied presence (2020-2021) and the number of hours for syllabi transaction (including practical hours) have been increased to 630 hours (in 2020-21, 2021-22).
- c. The Post Graduate Diploma in Clinical Musical Therapy (2018-20) (duration of the course 2 years) which was of 900 hours will now show an increase in practical hour input taking the duration of the course to 1440 hours.

**Recommendations:**

- 1) Dr. Gulshan Gidwani suggested to verify the requirement of minimum number of hours for Certificate and Diploma Courses. She emphasized the importance of adherence to UGC Guidelines for the same.
- 2) Dr. Manju Nichani appreciated the introduction of the Certificate Course on Stock Market and Investment as knowledge of Stock markets and courses of such nature are in great demand.

**Resolution 2:**

All of the new Certificate Courses and the extension in the number of practical hours of existing PG Diploma courses were appreciated and approved.

**Agenda 3: Any other issue to be considered as per permission of the Chair.**

The discussion on the TYBA Generic Elective courses and the 8 non-CGPA courses was said to be taken up at the forthcoming Academic Council meeting towards the end of 2021 or beginning of 2022 as per mutual convenience of the Academic Council members.

The meeting concluded with a Vote of Thanks by the Co-ordinator, Self - Financing Courses, Mrs. Rekha Kankariya.

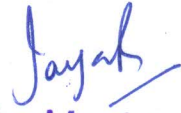

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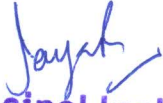
