Minutes of the Meeting:

1. To discuss the process of student aid:

Scholarships for students who don't come in the category of any government scholarship but are in need of financial aid to pay admission or exam fees. Student aid can be provided.

There are two ways of getting the funds i.e. Alumni Association and Volunteer donors. Account should also be maintained separately, which will be looked after by the Registrar, Mrs. Gauri Mhalgi, treasurer of the Alumni Association

For getting the details of the students need and how much deserving are they, it was decided that the student aid form should be filled by the students with proper documents.

To know all the difficulties faced by the students, so that we can decide how much aid can be given and it can also be shared with the donors. Funds cannot be given on verbal base but form should be filled for maintaining the records.

The process for student aid should go through proper channel i.e. first the Registrar, Mrs. Gauri Mhalgi, then Mrs. Hasina Shaikh will recommend after scrutiny, it will be decided by the members whether a part of scholarship or full scholarship should be provided. Wherever need is higher, full scholarship can be provided

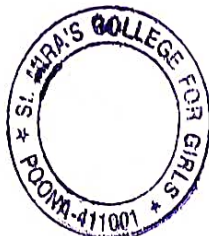

It was decided that at present, we should start giving aid to SY and TY students, only if the student from FY is in desperate need then we can take the decision for FY.

REPORT

Social service, community development are an integral part of Mira education.

It is a practice at St. Mira's College to help students who are unable to complete their education due to financial problem. In house faculty and college raised the funds to help these students.

Due to the COVID-19 lockdown, the parents/guardians of many of our students lost their jobs and hence, were not in a position to completely meet the educational expenses of their wards. The objective of this program is to help the girl students to continue their education.


Our Institution, empathized with the plight of our students' and pro-actively offered a facility for fee payment in instalments. Many students availed of this facility but have still not been able to fully meet their educational obligations. Many in- house faculty too, have made generous contributions, since we, at St. Mira's, believe that education is our students' right and no one should be deprived of the same. But that has not been adequate.

St. Mira's have formalized the student aid so that maximum students can get the benefit to come under the umbrella of completing education.


We have scrutinized the process by verifying the documents of the students and giving aid to those who are deserving.

This policy is benefiting students from student aid fund. No students are ever turned away from Mira Institution for want of money. Till date 32 students have been benefitted with student aid fund.

We, at St. Mira's College are trying to reach out to philanthropies and individuals who could sponsor our students' fees.
