The Department of Business Economics and Banking organized a three-day Webinar on 'Introduction to Financial Markets: Exploring Job and Self-employment Opportunities' from June 24-26, 2020. Ms. Suchitra Kashalkar, a former BSE Institute Trainer with more than 14 years of experience in Banking and Corporate sector, was the resource person at the Webinar.

The webinar was open to students from all the streams received an overwhelming registration.

During the course of the three-day webinar, an introduction to the concept of financial well-being was made, progressing to understand the nuances of Financial Investment and Planning, the working and operations of Mutual Funds and Equity Markets.
