SAINT MIRA


Our Patron Saint

The name "Mira" is synonymous with nobility, wisdom, Indian culture, courage, purity, service, sacrifice, and pure love.

Saint Mira stood for true freedom for women, born from the love of God and service to the poor.

She rose above the restraints of society, transforming from a rebel into a saint, asserting her dignity and ultimately surrendering her will to the Divine.

These qualities were the very ideals that Sadhu Vaswani wished young women to embody, and therefore he named his experiment in education after this saint of Indian history.



REV. SADHU VASWANI

Founder of the Mira Movement in Education

Sadhu Vaswani was a philosopher-saint, distinguished professor, and visionary educator who believed deeply in woman-power and woman-spirit, long before feminism was widely recognised.

He founded the Mira School in Sind in 1932, which was envisioned to grow into a university, but the Partition of the sub-continent forced relocation to India.

Maharashtra provided fertile ground for the Mira Movement in Education, leading to the establishment of Mira schools and St. Mira's College in 1962, one of the pioneering colleges exclusively for girls in the region.



DADA J. P. VASWANI

Spiritual Guide & Visionary Leader

Dada J. P. Vaswani was a globally respected spiritual leader, educationist and humanitarian who carried forward the legacy of the Mira Movement in Education. A powerful advocate of peace, compassion and ethical living, he inspired generations of students to combine intellectual growth with spiritual depth.

Under his guidance, the institutions of the Sadhu Vaswani Mission expanded their educational outreach while remaining rooted in values of service, discipline and character formation. His emphasis on women's empowerment, inner strength and universal brotherhood continues to shape the ethos of St. Mira's College.




ADMISSIONS & ACADEMIC INFORMATION

St. Mira's College for Girls accommodates students across Junior College, Undergraduate, and Postgraduate programmes in the streams of Arts, Commerce and Computer Science.

SEATS APPROVED

Admissions to all programmes are conducted strictly according to the sanctioned intake approved by Savitribai Phule Pune University and relevant regulatory authorities.

QUALIFYING EXAMINATION FOR ADMISSION

Students seeking admission to various programmes must have passed the qualifying examination recognized by the Government of Maharashtra or an equivalent board/university.

Undergraduate Programmes

Applicants must have successfully completed:

- Higher Secondary Certificate Examination (HSC)
- Or an equivalent examination from a recognized board

For BBA and BBA(CA)

- MAH-B.HMCT/BCA/BBA/BMS CET

Postgraduate Programmes

Applicants must possess:

- A Bachelor's Degree in the relevant discipline from a recognized university

Certain professional programmes may require additional entrance examinations or eligibility criteria prescribed by the University or regulatory bodies.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

The selection of candidates is carried out according to merit and eligibility guidelines prescribed by the University and the College.

SUBMISSION OF REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

Applicants must upload or submit all necessary academic documents and certificates for verification.

PUBLICATION OF MERIT LISTS

The College prepares merit lists based on eligibility criteria and marks obtained in the qualifying examination.

DOCUMENT VERIFICATION

Selected candidates must present original documents for verification as instructed by the college.

PAYMENT OF FEES

Admission is confirmed only after payment of the prescribed fees within the stipulated deadline.

CONFIRMATION OF ADMISSION

Once the admission process is completed successfully, the student receives confirmation of admission from the College.

Admissions to the Junior College (Standard XI) are conducted as per the guidelines of the Maharashtra State Board of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education through the centralized online admission process. Students who have successfully completed the Secondary School Certificate (SSC) examination or its equivalent from a recognized board are eligible to apply.

The College reserves the right to verify documents and reject applications if eligibility conditions are not fulfilled.

DOCUMENTS REQUIRED FOR ADMISSION

After filling out the form, the same has to be downloaded and submitted to the College Office along with the following documents [in original with 2 duly attested Xerox/photocopies]:

- Statement of Marks of SSC, HSC or equivalent examination
- School Leaving Certificate /Transfer Certificate
- Caste Certificate (if belonging to reserved category)
- Domicile Certificate (if belonging to a State other than Maharashtra State)
- Physical Disability Certificate (if belonging to Category of Physically Handicapped)
- Transfer Order (if parents are transferred to Pune as State / Central Government Employees)
- Passing Certificate from the Board and Migration Certificate (if belonging to other than Pune University/Maharashtra State Board)
- One latest Identity Card Size Photograph

Only candidates who are selected in accordance with the Minority Quota Rules or as per the Merit and Reservation Policy laid down by the Office of the Deputy Director of Education, Pune Region are considered for admission

RULES REGARDING CANCELLATION OF ADMISSION & REFUND OF FEES

If a student wishes to cancel her admission after confirmation, she must submit a written application for cancellation to the college office. For refund rules refer to the admission form.



ACADEMIC BANK OF CREDITS (ABC ID)

The Academic Bank of Credits (ABC) is a digital platform introduced under the National Education Policy (NEP 2020) to facilitate flexible and transparent academic mobility for students.


Students enrolled in undergraduate and postgraduate programmes are required to create an ABC ID, which serves as a digital repository for their academic credits.

- Allows academic institutions to lodge and maintain the integrity of the credits.
- Maintains the authenticity and confidentiality of student credits.
- Easy credit transfer through digital mode.
- Faster credit recognition

Key Features of ABC

- Allows multiple entries, multiple exit for students.
- Stores student credit for a minimum shelf life of 7 years.
- Transfer credit through a single window after approval of source and destination academic institution.
- Only verified academic institutions can upload credits.
- Improves transparency and helps to build a more flexible approach to curriculum design and development.

Students are required to generate their ABC ID through the official Government portal and link it with their university records as part of the admission process.



STUDENT DECLARATIONS

ANTI-RAGGING UNDERTAKING




AUDITORIUM & CULTURAL SPACES

SPORTS & PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT

Sports activities at St. Mira's College are actively encouraged to promote physical fitness, discipline and holistic well-being.
